Goals

Focus for Poteet Intermediate Campus

Team Collaboration

Teachers will meet weekly to discuss data, curriculum, lesson plans, interventions, and best teaching practices. ESC XX will provide professional development in all core content areas once per month.

Daily Interventions

Teachers will provide daily interventions to students who are struggling academically. Teachers will use data collected and develop a plan to determine what interventions are needed for each student.

Literacy Development

ELAR teachers will use balanced literacy materials to provide instruction and close reading gaps. Guided reading groups will occur daily.

Attendance

Teachers and campus administration will work together to improve student attendance. Conferences and home visits will occur when needed for face-to-face and remote learners. The goal for campus attendance is 97%.

Technology

Teachers will incorporate technology daily into their lessons. Through the use of canvas and other appropriate programs, students will become familiar with a blended learning model.
